(一) **Lin Yu-ting: A Brave Olympic gold medalist boxer Inspires Taiwan Youth**

Taiwanese boxer Lin Yu-ting has gone through a lot of trouble because of a widely talked-about argument over her gender and whether she should be allowed to compete while she worked to win a gold medal at the Paris Olympics. Since then, she ___(1)___ support and love from her fans in Taiwan luckily.

Cute drawings have filled the pages of a notebook with praise and support from the daughter of a well-known doctor at National Taiwan University Hospital, Dr. Jin-Chung Shih. She has written that "[Lin's] bravery is more valuable than a gold medal," and that she has ___(2)___ the people of Taiwan together. One of the most touching parts is her quote from Eleanor Roosevelt, saying that "___(3)___" You never know how strong she is until she gets in hot water."

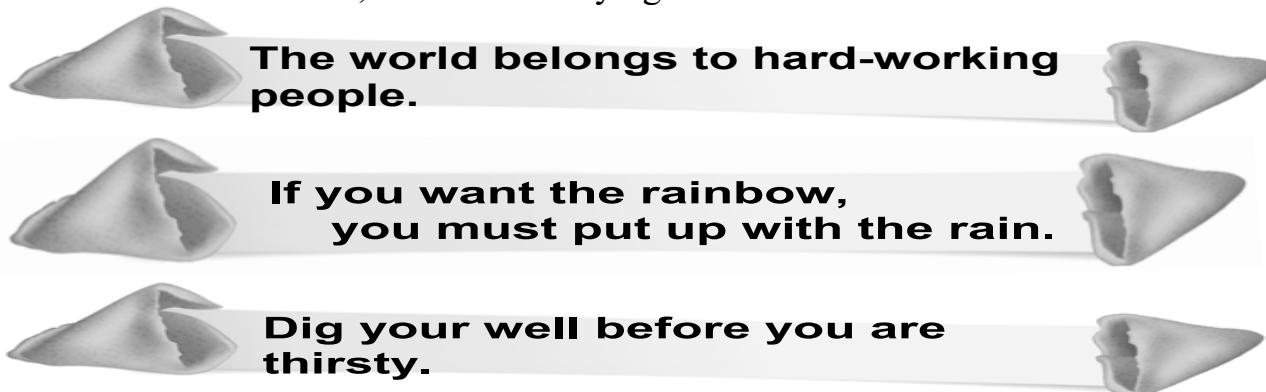

It was a long tradition for the Japanese to make cookies with eggs, butter, sugar, and flour. Around the 1900s, they began to put little notes in cookies to tell a person's fortune. At that time, they became a part of the food culture there. With this tradition in mind, Makoto Hagiwara started to make fortune cookies in the USA.

Before the 1950s, bakers often made fortune cookies either with their hands or with chopsticks, so it took them a long time to make the cookies. That changed when Shuck Yee, a Chinese American, invented a machine to make the cookies faster. This made them popular at Chinese restaurants across the USA.

Today, many Chinese restaurants in the USA serve fortune cookies at the end of a meal. They are well-known not for their taste, but for their sayings. Here are some common fortunes:

Alicia knew some people would have problems with that, so she came up with the idea of a blue Halloween bucket in 2018, instead of the more common orange pumpkin bucket. She thought that when people saw it, they would know the person had special needs. Then she posted it on Facebook, and people were deeply touched and shared it over 28,000 times.

We're all pretty used to the normal Halloween night practices when it comes to trick-or-treat. Kids ring the doorbell, say "trick or treat" and quickly receive some candy. But, it's important to notice that some children with special needs may be nonverbal. Because of this, saying "trick or treat!" as soon as the door is opened may not happen, but that doesn't mean that child doesn't still deserve the best Halloween candy. Seeing the blue bucket and being aware is the most important step!

Now, a blue Halloween bucket has become a sign for kids with special needs. Just a bit of knowledge and kindness can go a long way for some kids on Halloween.
