When Apollo crossed the sky, she turned her face and followed Apollo with her eyes. In the end, she turned into the sunflower, a kind of flower that always faces the sun.*

People often use the love story of Greek myth to tell children how a sunflower was born to the world and why the flower's head always follows the sun. However, the idea that sunflowers "always" move their heads from east to west to follow the sun is a misconception. In fact, not every sunflower follows the sun. Only the young ones do. They follow the sun during the day, so they can get as much sunlight as possible and grow up quickly. During the night, they move their faces from west to east to wait for the next time the sun rises. After the flowers fully grow up, they stop moving their faces with the sun because the mature plants have something more important to do—bearing seeds. They spend half a day getting sunlight and the rest of the day bearing seeds. So, they always face east. Next time you pass a piece of land full of sunflowers, look closely. You will see that not every flower is facing the sun.

Do you like to have a cup of coffee after you get up? Lots of people do. However, did you know that we might not be able to see some bird species in the future if we don't choose our coffee beans carefully?

Coffee trees grow in the tropics. To grow them, people have to cut down many other types of trees there. When there are fewer kinds of trees in one area, the number of bird species drops as well. And when there are fewer bird species, the ecosystem becomes less healthy because birds are important to many plants and other animals.

Studies have shown that on a coffee bean farm, more than 61% of bird species become fewer in number every year. Some bird species even disappear in the end. However, if farmers grow some other kinds of trees on their coffee bean farms, it'll be a big help to the birds. The number of these bird species won't drop so fast, and the ecosystem can stay healthy.

If you'd like to do something to help the birds, you can follow the "Bird Friendly Coffee Program." People who work with the program have done lots of studies on coffee beans from around the world, and they write reports to tell people which of the beans are friendly to an ecosystem. For example, coffee beans from Ethiopia and Kenya are friendlier to the birds and the Earth because people there don't cut down trees to grow coffee trees. They just grow them under other trees there. Coffee beans from these two countries might be more expensive, but they do the least harm to birds.

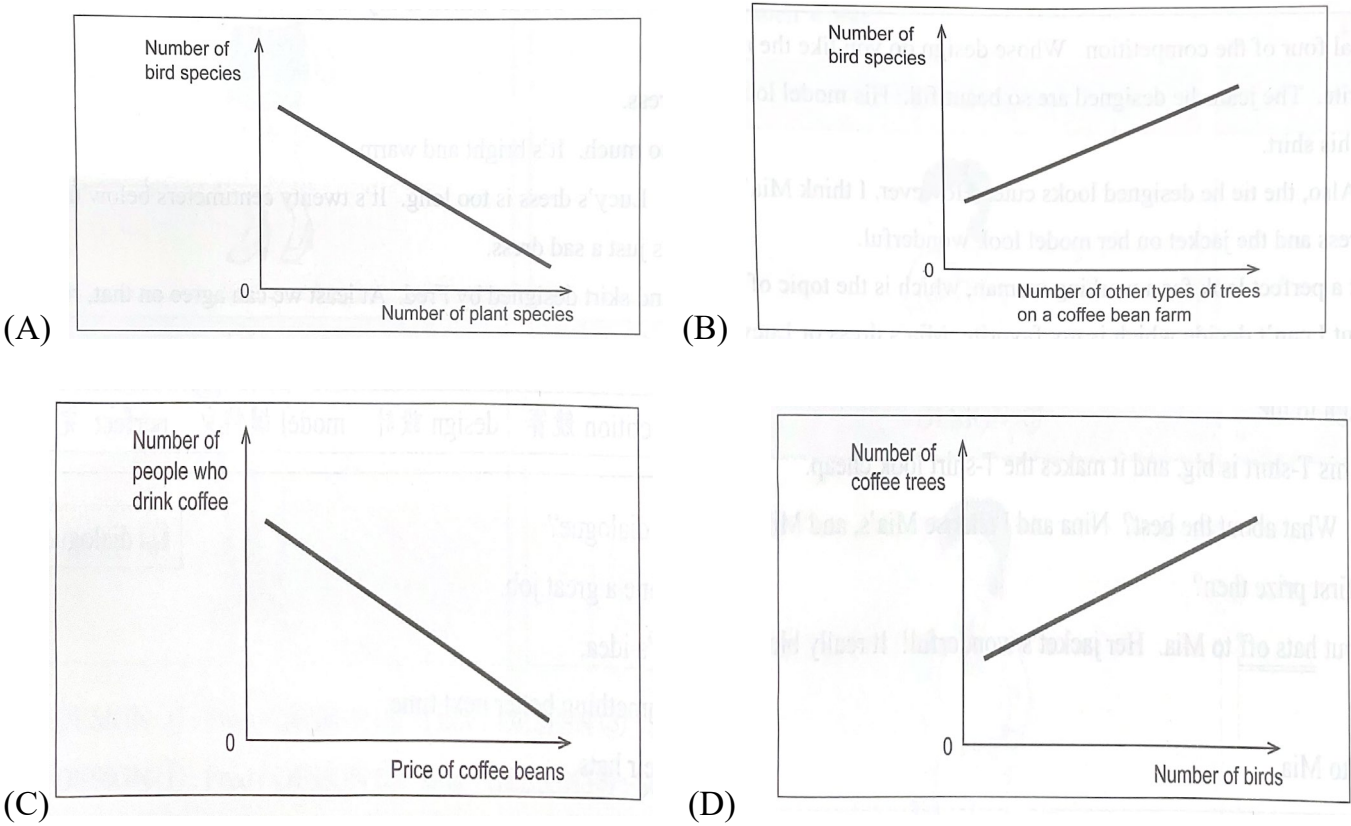
